CUSTOMS NOTICE 13-022

Proposed Regulatory Amendments to the *Customs Sufferance Warehouses* Regulations – Annual Licence Fee Removal

- 1. This notice announces regulatory amendments proposed by the Canada Border Services Agency to remove the licence fee charged under the *Customs Sufferance Warehouses Regulations*. It is further proposed that these regulatory amendments come into force on April 1, 2014, on the condition that the Governor in Council makes the regulatory amendment.
- 2. The customs sufferance warehouses licence fee will no longer be collected commencing with the 2014-2015 fiscal year.

Proposed Regulatory Changes

3. It is proposed that section 5 of the *Customs* Sufferance Warehouses Regulations be repealed to remove the requirement that every licensee pay a fee. It is also proposed that subsection 3(1) be amended to remove the requirement that an amount of fee be paid under section 5.
